

Request for GP to write a letter

Please be aware that if you need a letter from the doctor for any reason, there will be a charge as this is not covered by normal GP services.

The doctors do not issue letters stating patients are unfit to attend court or “fit” to do any activities such as use a gym, run a marathon, parachute, cycle or participate in any activity they have chosen to, as they have no specialist way of assessing this.

In some cases, a summary of medical problems can be provided to allow the relevant party to make their own decision on your fitness.

Please don't be offended when any such request is declined

If you do need a letter, please complete the form on the reverse and give it to the receptionist along with the fee (minimum of £20)

These letters are a non-NHS service and are entirely at the doctor's discretion. Should the doctor decide not to write the letter (for instance if there is no medical reason) then your money will be reimbursed

Requests usually take 14-21 days
